## Self Care

### - STAY INFORMED -

### - SECURITY -

Metal detectors are used to help keep the convention space safe. Visit our *Security* section under the policies tab on our website for more information.

### - STAY HYDRATED -

Pack a water bottle!  
Personal beverage containers are allowed.



### - STAY CHARGED -

No outside food is allowed in the convention center, keep snacks in your car or plan out places to eat nearby.
