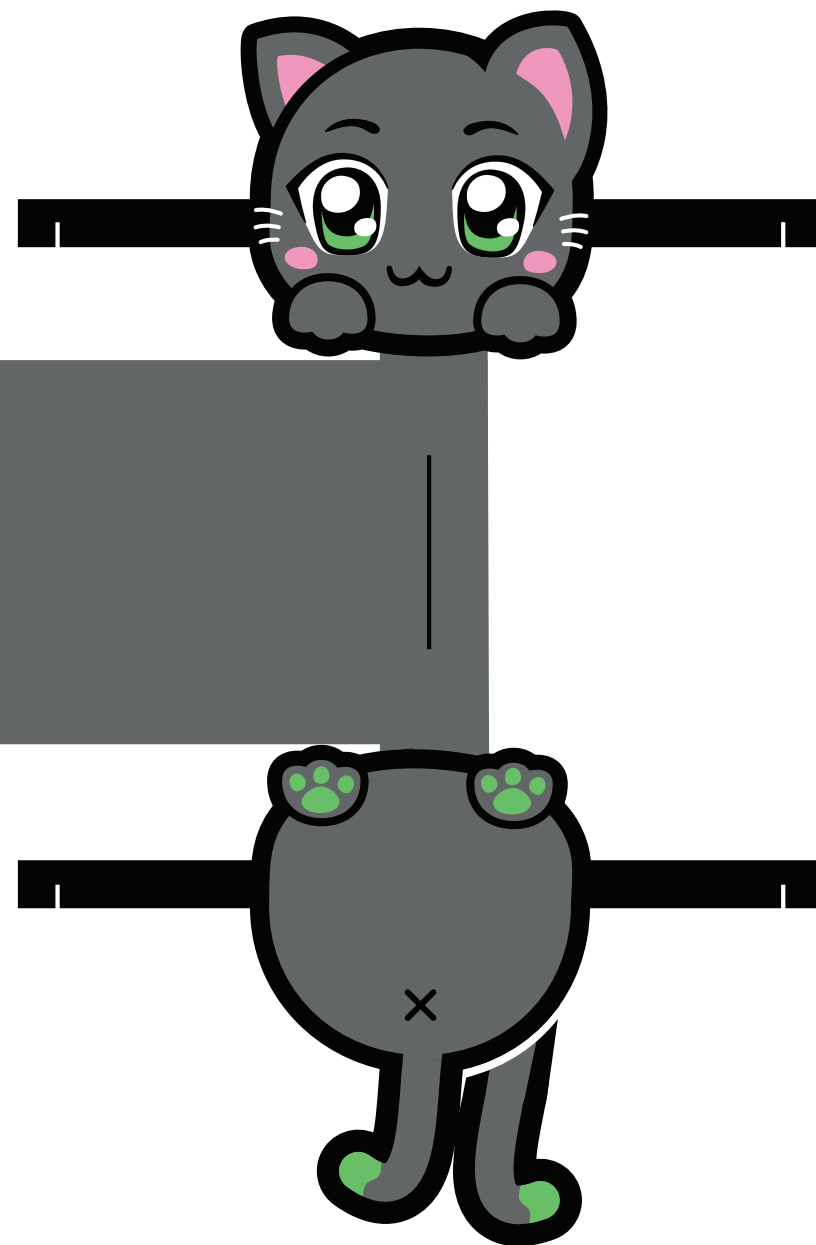
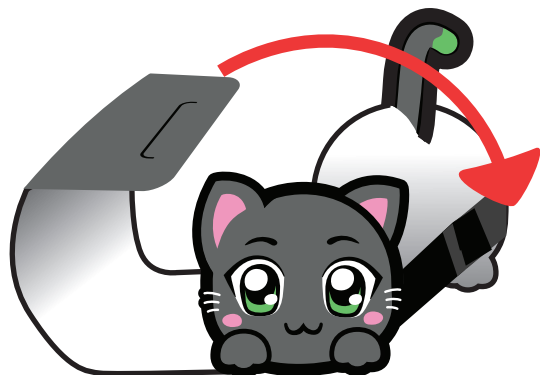
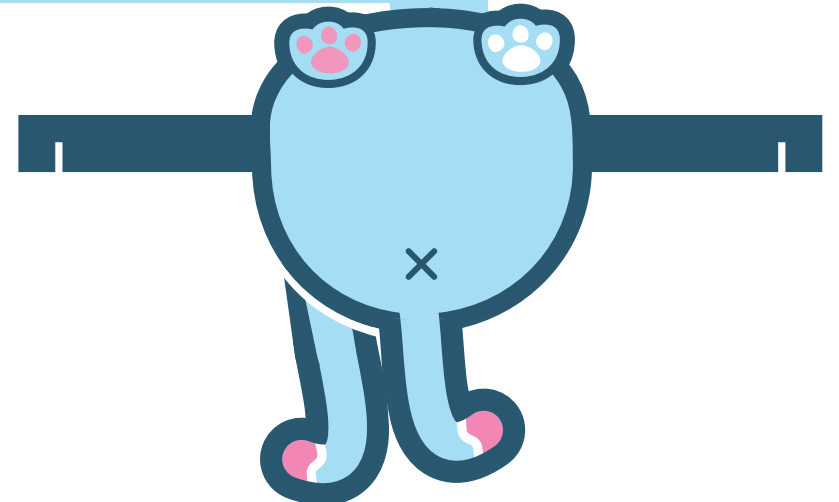
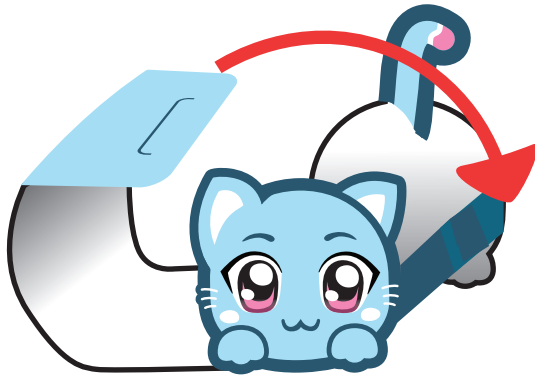


Papercraft Tsuki



- Step 1. Slice the two lines printed inside of the long body
Then, cut around the outside of the papercraft print
- Step 2. Fold the tail over to match itself
- Step 3. Place the papercraft color-side down & fold the front/back parts up
- Step 4. Fold the tabs on either side of the front/back towards each other and slide their slots together (or use tape*)
- Step 5. Roll the body around the tabs and insert* into the slot to create a cylinder
